Yong-en is located in the heart of Chinatown on Smith Street, just behind Oriental Plaza and RHC. Their direct services are meeting critical needs for many children, families and elderly through the following three core services:

- Counselling, Social and Referral Services
- Dementia Day Care
- Home Care Service

RHC has a fantastic opportunity to partner with Yong-en and serve our neighbors by providing practical assistance and support. We are seeking committed volunteers who desire to build relationships with local residents through acts of service and dedicated time to outreach programs.

Dementia Day Care Service

- Volunteers facilitate fun, energizing games while simultaneously serving and befriending the clients in their regular daily activities from 10:30am-12:30pm every other Monday.
- Outreach takes place in Yong-en's office: Blk 335A, #03-57 Smith Street.

Monthly Food Distribution and Befriending

- Volunteers distribute food parcels to individuals and families within rental block units on Kreta Ayer Road and Banda Street, Chinatown. Each volunteer is assigned to a small group, which visits the same households every month (typically three). "Households" include large families with small children, the elderly, and individuals with disabilities. Cantonese and Hokkien language skills desired but not required.

Training will be provided by RHC and Yong-en. A minimum commitment of six months is required.
