Truths that Make us Sing

Q49: What does God require in the first and second commandment?

In the first, that I sincerely acknowledge the only true God, trust him alone, look to him for every good thing, love him, fear him and honour him with all my heart.

In short, that I give up anything rather than go against his will in any way.

In the second, that we in no way make any image of God, nor worship him in any other way than he has commanded in his Word.

Q50: What is God's will for us in the third and fourth commandment?

In the third, that we neither blaspheme nor misuse the name of God, but rather that we use the holy name of God only with reverence and awe, so that we may properly confess him, pray to him and praise him in everything we do and say.

In the fourth, that we daily rest in Christ and gather weekly with his people for corporate worship, and so anticipate the eternal Sabbath.

"Truths that Make us Sing" is a series of questions and answers designed by RHC to convey the essential truths of the Christian faith and stir our hearts to worship God. It has been adapted from the New City Catechism and Reformation Catechisms. Read through, think upon and pray through these truths, and then worship God with the recommended song.
